Our services for child victims of sexual abuse include:

- ♦ Forensic Interviews
- Medical Exams
- ♦ Advocacy

Care Cottage Mission:

The mission of the Kentucky River Child Advocacy Center is to provide a comfortable, safe environment where children who have victims of sexual abuse and their non-offending caregivers may receive services from each agency involved in the investigation and prosecution of these cases. We strive to provide a location where investigations may be preformed in as timely manner as possible and to link children and families to services they may need both immediately and in the future.

As fall comes around, so does the beginning of school and Back-to-School Bashes. This year the Care Cottage was invited to celebrate going back to school with Mountain After Hours Clinic and the Hazard School System. These events gave the Care Cottage the opportunity to provide school supplies to children in the area, as well as provide information on the Care Cottage, consent, abuse, prevention, and how to get help. The Care Cottage was also able to provide information to students on the effects of drugs, alcohol, and vaping. Pantosaurus was able to join us at the Hazard Independent Schools event and was a huge hit with the kids and teens alike.











The global pandemic has impacted everyone. The Care Cottage is no exception. While cases of sexual abuse have risen only 10%, physical abuse numbers have increased by 83% and neglect has risen 650%. Educators account for approximately 30% of all child abuse reports. Children were isolated in their homes due to the pandemic and Care Cottage number reflect the negative impact this has had on the children we serve. To help combat these increases in numbers, the Care Cottage is proud to provide the following training to the community and community partners at no cost. 

Stewards of Children® is a prevention training that teaches adults how to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. The program is designed for organizations that serve youth and for individuals concerned about the safety of children. It is the only nationally distributed, evidence-informed program proven to increase knowledge, improve attitudes, and change child protective behaviors.
